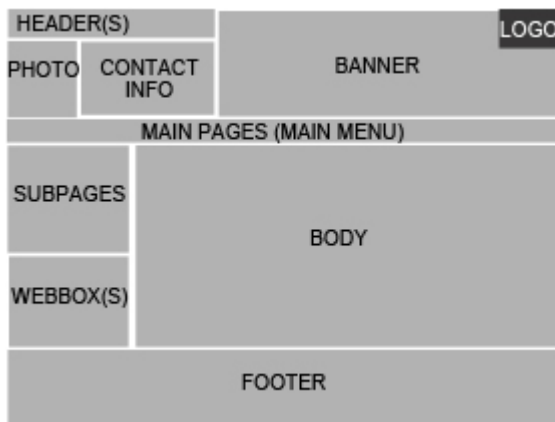


# Planning Your Website Layout

When designing the structure of your site, remember that Main Pages are displayed in the Main Menu bar, and Subpages are displayed on the left or the right of the site (depending on your chosen theme) as part of the Subpage Menu. Since each Subpage belongs to a Main Page, clicking a Main Page in the main menu will automatically display the appropriate Subpage menu items.

Below are the site layouts created by the three Customizable Designs available for your site. Notice the Subpages are displayed in column the left, while the Main Pages are displayed in a horizontal bar above.

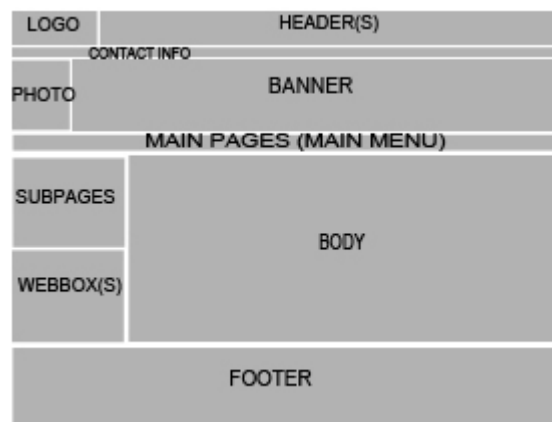

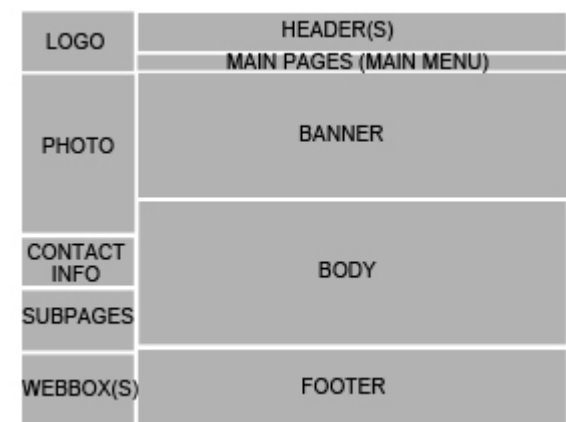

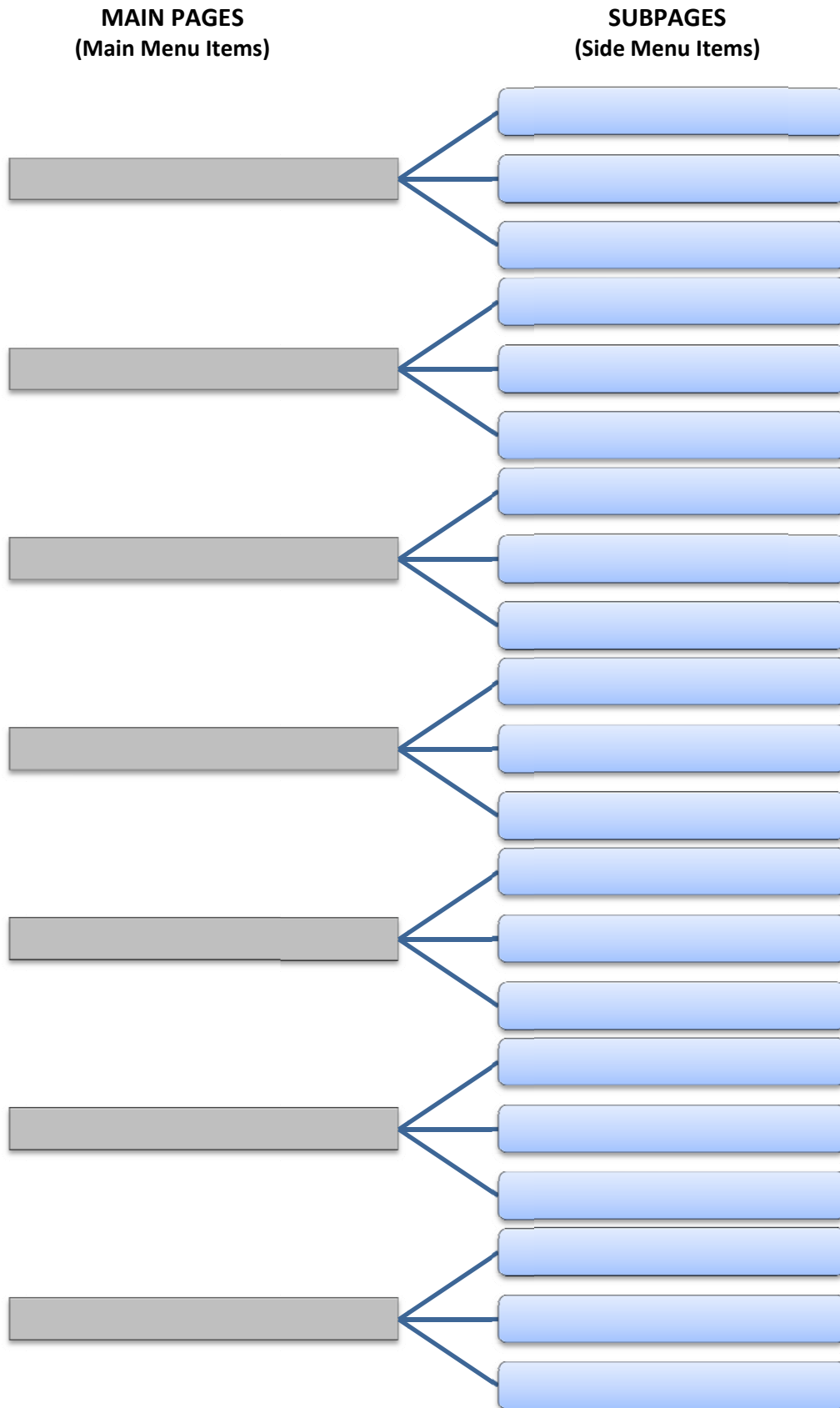

**Please Note:** If you are using a **Default Theme** design instead of one of these **Customizable Designs**, some Default Layouts place the Subpages and Web Boxes on the rightside of the page rather than the left.
